Of Interest...

A delicious no-bake cake.

Hot Cross Bun Layer Cake

Zest and juice of 1 orange
200g caster sugar
Zest of 1 lemon
4 medium egg yolks
50ml cognac or sherry (optional)
325ml double cream
325ml mascarpone cheese – softened

100g raisins
100g mixed peel
100g chocolate chips
8 hot cross buns – about 600g
½ TBSP icing sugar
½ TSP mixed spice



Measure the orange juice in a jug and make up to 100ml with water, if needed. Pour into a pan with half the caster sugar and, over a low heat, dissolve. Turn up the heat and simmer for 2 minutes. Remove from the heat, stir in the lemon and orange zest, then set aside to cool.

For the filling, put the yolks, remaining sugar and cognac, if using, into a bowl set over a pan of gently simmering water. With an electric handheld beater, whisk for 5 minutes until thickened and it leaves a ribbon trail. Remove from the heat and whisk for a few more minutes to help it cool.

In a separate bowl, whisk the cream until it just holds soft peaks. Whisk the mascarpone into the egg-yolk mixture, then fold in the cream. Stir through 75g each of the raisins, peel and chocolate chips.

Slice the hot cross buns in half horizontally. Place the ring (without the base) of a 23cm springform cake tin on a cake stand. Brush inside with some of the citrus sugar syrup. Squash a third of the hot cross bun pieces over the base of the tin (you may need to tear them), then brush with the syrup. Spoon over a third of the mascarpone mixture. Repeat twice more, finishing with the mascarpone. Chill to set, ideally overnight in the fridge.

To serve, unclip the ring and lift off. Sprinkle with the remaining peel, raisins and chocolate chips. Mix the icing sugar and spice, then sift over the top.
